

Sidewalk Ordinance Resolution

WHEREAS, Chapter 58, Article IX, Section 58-528 (c) (2) c. of the Township Code of Ordinances allows the Township Board to set payment terms for expenses associated with the repairs of defective sidewalks, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 58, Article IX, Section 58-528 (d) of the Township Code of Ordinances allows the Township Board to contribute towards the expenses associated with the repairs of defective sidewalks in certain instances;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following terms and conditions are hereby adopted for the calendar year 2015:

Payment Terms – Upon application for financial hardship, the Township Treasurer is authorized to apply sidewalk repair expenses to the 2015 tax roll and thus, defer payment until the time taxes are due. Such payment terms shall only apply where the property owner uses the township contractor for repairs.

Township Contribution - Where a curb ramp is determined to be defective by the Township Engineer, the Township will contribute \$100 towards the expense of installing tactile warning strips, where required by federal legislation. Such contribution shall only apply where the property owner uses the township contractor for replacement of the defective curb ramp.

The above terms and conditions only apply to the calendar year 2015. The Township Board may consider renewing or modifying the provisions by future resolution.
